

Job Description—Recreational Gymnastics Coach in Training

We are seeking a mature and reliable part time employee who loves children, has a flexible schedule and has their own transportation. This person must have some experience working in a recreational, customer service or educational position or has experience working with children. Must be willing to become certified in Level 1 Gymnastics and Trampoline. Lots of potential for growth within the club and within the industry if interested in a career in coaching or recreational services. **Must be available** for a few weekday evenings and Saturdays.

Full training is provided.

Will need to provide a police check and a vulnerable sector check

Will need to obtain First Aid and CPR

Key Responsibilities

The employee will lead and facilitate classes for children ages 18 months to 10 years to start. Full training as a CIT (Coach in Training) will be provided. Training is paid by the employee under conditions. The employee will meet and greet kids as they come to class, follow all safety and cleaning protocols, do equipment checks, take attendance, lead a class (after full training and some shadowing) based on the provided curriculum, then follow end of class procedures. This person may also need to cover a class for other coaches, be asked to help out at a fundraising event, take part in coaching clinics and workshops and will need to stay abreast of new information, obtain their coaching certification and maintain this certification via in person and online mini courses and workshops, made available by the club.

Experience working with children is preferred

Must have your own transportation

Must be mature, responsible and reliable, have great communication skills as well as
